OhioMHAS Updates from Molly Stone – OhioMHAS, Prevention Bureau Chief

- New rules for consolidated agency. Revised Prevention Rule goes into effect April 1, 2016. For more information on the rules and webinars visit:

- The new rules are broken out into separate rules. This is a change from the old rule where prevention was all in one rule.

Grant Updates

- SPF PFS EBP Workgroup update from Dawn Thomas
 - The SPF-PFS EBP workgroup is not meeting regularly at this time. The group will provide feedback on the upcoming RFP. It will meet more next fiscal year.
- Committee for Diversity & Inclusion (CDI) from Dawn Thomas
 - Working to build the community members. If you would like to participate or have any suggestions for other people who would be interested, please send Dawn Thomas an email

- by the end of next week (dawn.thomas@mha.ohio.gov). The committee will focus on diversity in prevention throughout our state during the SPF-PFS grant period and beyond.
- Members can be members of other SPF-PFS committees (Advisory Committee or EBP Workgroup) but do not have to be.
 - SEOW (State Epi. Outcomes Workgroup) updates from Lara Belliston
 - SEOW will have a sub-group dedicated to the SPF-PFS work. Some revisions were made to the SEOW Scope of Work. The revisions and member list will be available next meeting. SEOW data will be displayed on Network of Care website where the county-level data has been prioritized over state-level data
 - OHYES (Ohio Healthy Youth Environments Survey): Collected over 35,000 surveys for OHYES so far, and some schools still plan on participating. OhioMHAS is working with the Ohio Department of Health and Network of Care to get the results displayed, hopefully by the end of March.
 - Dawn took a moment to remind the advisory committee about how all the parts of the SPF-PFS grant are integral to the success of the grant. See attached diagram.
 - SPF-PFS OCAM Network from Mary Haag
 - Primary purpose is training/technical assistance through a team of coaches. OCAM was working on developing infrastructure during the past 6 months and is focused on a long-term strategy for the state. PreventionFIRST! will provide CEUs for trainings.
 - Effort has gone into bringing the coaches together, and recently the coaches completed Community Capacity and Readiness Interviews. One goal of OCAM is to build coaches to be able to train communities on ethics, etc.
 - An announcement has gone out to communities about existence of OCAM and SPF-PFS eligible communities will continue to be contacted when training or technical assistance is available through the OCAM Network
 - Scholarships for ADAPAO and OPEC conferences will be announced shortly. Some of the people may have gotten the announcement, but the whole advisory committee will receive the OCAM network announcement.
 - Training updates from Derek Longmeier
 - Upcoming webinar from OCAM. On April 14, 2016 on Opiates, Alcohol and Other Drugs, How do we know? Looking at data collection and how to champion partnerships within communities. Details will be released soon. This webinar may be the first in a series. It will be an hour of information about various types of data and how it can be used to build community connection around prevention.
 - Ethics training working on that May 5 following the ADAPAO conference. This is currently tentative.
 - SAPST (Substance Abuse Prevention Skills Training) is a 4-day training with a half-day web based component. It is currently happening through DFAA. Additional information about SPF, and overall behavioral health and wellness. Good for people who are newer to the field or those who need a refresher. It is a great way to get hours for certification or recertification.
 - Regional Learning Collaborative from Stacey Gibson
 - The RLCs are small group meetings to help move prevention specialists throughout the credentialing process. Talk about resources, increase knowledge, make aware of trainings,

provide materials on prevention science, and create a network of support. The flyer was attached to the email which included the agenda.

- SPF-PFS OSET from Dr. Holly Raffle – Lead Evaluator
 - OSET is a combined effort from Ohio University Voinovich School of Public Affairs and the Pacific Institute for Research and Evaluation (PIRE).
 - Community Capacity and Readiness interviews began on January 13, 2016 and are almost done. OSET and OCAM as well as OhioMHAS were used to complete the interviews. . 37 counties participated totaling a 66% cooperation rate. There were two interviews with audio issues, so 62.5% of the total interviews requested are usable at this point. Twenty-two have been transcribed. The next step is the analysis.
 - OSET is working with Abe Wandersman on with instrumentation and analysis as it relates to Community Readiness interviews.
- Theory of Change for state was attached to email from Holly. It will be required for sub-recipients to have a Theory of Change (TOC); the state's (TOC) can serve as a model. This version includes comments from Advisory Committee. There were no comments on which version of the document was better, but the document did a good job of defining the purpose and scope of the project.

- SPF-PFS RFP Discussion from Dawn Thomas
 - The RFP for sub-recipients is not drafted. Coaches would like to the RFP to be clean, neat, and simple.
 - What does the committee want to see or what we should not do again?
 - Eloise: The choice to exclude previous SPF-SIG sub-recipients was mentioned and having been locked out of another SPF-SIG is not great. They are currently in Columbiana County but working with Jefferson County. It could have been helpful if EB practices could have been expanded into other counties through the use of previous SPF SIG sub-recipients
 - Some members would like to review and comment once it is drafted.
